Donors can give blood on Saturday, August 5th from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at Inspire's Bristol location. Anyone can donate, and all donors will receive free drinks and snacks.

According to the American Red Cross, "Summer can be a difficult collection time because of busy schedules, traveling time spent on vacations, and students being out of school. Blood donors are especially needed during this time."
